



“Sanremo, Flower City”

(distance: 72 km)



Sanremo is an elegant seaside resort, famous for its **Festival of the Italian Song** and its **Casino**, which was built in Liberty style at the beginning of the 20th century.

Sightseeing: the **Russian Church**, in Byzantine style with 5 domes; the **Cathedral of San Siro** of the 13th century in romanico-gothic style in the centre of the town; **Villa Nobel** and **Villa Ormond**, not so far from each other, both of them have wonderful gardens.



The centre of **Sanremo** is also famous for its **elegant shops** and for its shops of typical products along the two main shopping streets: **Corso Matteotti**, where you can see the fashionable shop windows, and **Via Palazzo**, where you can buy typical products.

From Via Palazzo, going through the city gates along the historical walls, you can take the narrow streets to **the old quarter of “La Pigna”**, the medieval hamlet with its circular shape up on the hill. On the hill you can visit the “Regina Elena” Gardens, and you can reach the Sanctuary of **Madonna della Costa**, which overlooks the whole city and offers a breathtaking view.

It is worth visiting the colourful market in the big square Eroi Sanremesi every Tuesday and Saturday morning.
